Conifer Park is a 225-bed inpatient treatment facility situated on 32 wooded acres in Glenville, New York. Conifer Park offers specialized programming for adults, adolescents and their families affected by the disease of alcoholism and chemical dependency. Inpatient services include detoxification, gender specific programming, a discrete adolescent unit, short-term stabilization, dual recovery services, and a family program. Outpatient services include intensive programming (both day and evening), adolescent programming, dual recovery services and family therapy. Conifer Park operates outpatient clinics in Glenville, Glens Falls, Plattsburgh, Rochester, Syracuse, Schenectady, and Troy.

Programs offered by Conifer Park are accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations and licensed by the New York State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services.

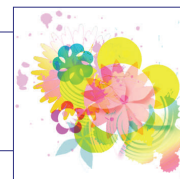

Increases in the incidence of post traumatic stress disorder, substance use disorders, and suicide are disturbing trends affecting those serving in our current Military. This presentation will provide an overview of the biological and phenomenological aspects of traumatic exposure, highlighting the co-morbidity of trauma and substance use disorders among Service Members and Veterans. The increased risk of suicide related to both, and post traumatic stress disorder and substance abuse disorders will also be reviewed. Finally, implications for both prevention and effective treatment models will also be discussed.
