Conifer Park is a 225-bed inpatient treatment facility situated on 32 wooded acres in Glenville, New York. Conifer Park offers specialized programming for adults, adolescents and their families affected by the disease of alcoholism and chemical dependency. Inpatient services include detoxification, gender specific programming, a discrete adolescent unit, short-term stabilization, dual recovery services, and a family program. Outpatient services include intensive programming (both day and evening), adolescent programming, dual recovery services and family therapy. Conifer Park operates outpatient clinics in Glenville, Glens Falls, Plattsburgh, Rochester, Syracuse, Schenectady, and Troy.

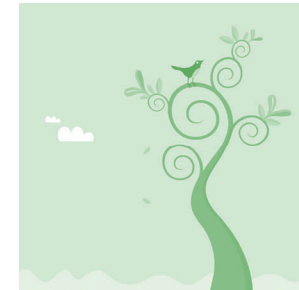
